


July 4th: March for Truth in the Takoma Park Parade and Lunch Picnic Afterwards

Please join DC911Truth.org members in the Takoma Park, MD parade and a potluck picnic after the parade.

The Parade

Meet at Sue and Phil Wheaton's house, **7211 Spruce Ave., Takoma Park, MD 20912 beginning at 8:15 a.m.** to drop off your lunch potluck food and drink and begin decorating the "Truth Mobile" (pick-up truck). Leave around 9 a.m. to assemble for the parade. DC9/11Truth is in Division 3, which assembles on Carroll Ave. between Lee and Sherman Avenues. The parade starts at 10 a.m. and goes for two hours: south on Carroll to Maple and back up Maple to the reviewing stand at Takoma City Hall.



Transportation, Streets, Parking

Metro: Takoma is on the Metro Red Line; Sue's house is a 10 minute walk from it; The parade staging area is a 15-20 minute walk from the Metro and a 10 minute walk from Sue's house.

Streets: If you drive, plan to arrive early and no later than 9:30 a.m., when all streets in the parade area close. After 9 a.m., all streets in the assembly area close and, as stated above, DC9/11Truth will have left Sue's house to go line up for the parade.

Parking: Parking is scarce on side streets near the parade staging area and on streets around Sue's house. Parade participants may park in the side lot of the Franklin Apartments at 7620 Maple Ave and at the vacant lot at the corner of Ethan Allen and Jackson Ave., across from the church. Limited parking is available at the city lot between the firehouse and the Food Co-op on Ethan Allen. All of these are a short walk to the parade staging area (but not necessarily to Sue's house). For those who can walk a bit, there's plenty of parking at the Takoma Middle School at 7611 Piney Branch Road. The Middle School is just up the hill on Ritchie Ave., where the parade ends, and it's a convenient place to both the parade staging area and the end of the parade.

The driveway at 7211 Spruce Ave. is shared with the next door neighbor, so please do not park there.

The Lunch Potluck Picnic

It's right after the parade in Sue's backyard, 7211 Spruce Ave. Bring any kind of dish to share, something to serve it in and a utensil to serve it with, plus any wine or beer you like; soft drinks (tea, water, soda) will be provided, along with plates, eating utensils, etc.
